## Autism Arts



The Autism Arts program invites participants ages 6-25 years old with autism to explore art media through self-expression. The program creates an opportunity for new friendships to develop and participants to take part in a positive recreational experience within the community.

Autism Arts utilizes a unique model developed by Autism Nova Scotia in partnership with the Art Gallery of Nova Scotia, located in Halifax. Autism Arts is also available at the Yarmouth Art Gallery in partnership with the Southwest Nova Chapter of Autism Nova Scotia.

Autism Arts incorporates a team teaching approach, including an autism professional (Recreation Therapist, Art Educator and/or Autism Behavioural Coordinator). The team works together to maximize the success of each participant's experience.



Autism Arts consists of eight-week sessions that take place on Saturdays during three terms: Fall, Winter, and Spring. You can find information and registration forms on our website.
