The Ben James Summer Camp is a recreation program for children and youth with autism between the ages of 6-21 years old. Each camper is supported with a 1:1 camper/counsellor ratio and activities are designed specifically with participants' needs and interests in mind.

Parents and caregivers can rest easy knowing their children are enjoying fun-filled activities while also being supported by trained and dedicated counsellors.

Camp operates in four sessions during July and August from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Friday. Campers involved in the summer camp program actively participate in their community on a daily basis.
